This individual will coordinate all work with the Superintendent, Project Manager as other contractors as needed to maintain the project schedule and the proper flow of work.

Lead Carpenter

Start by leading a small crew and overseeing small projects. Perform carpentry tasks with the highest quality of craftsmanship in the time allotted.

Master Carpenter


Pinnacle of craftsmanship within the company. Familiar with building code requirements in order to create high-quality and structurally sound buildings or end products.
