Housekeeper

- Directly supervises Team Members in the Housekeeping Department.
- Assists Manager in directing Housekeeping program.
- Schedules Team Members' daily work routines.
- Establishes standards and procedures for work of Housekeeping staff.
- Evaluates Team Member performance and performs coaching/counseling.
- Starting wage is \$21.00/hour.

- Responsible for working in any Housekeeping role within the community whenever necessary.
- Assumes oversight responsibility in the absence of the supervisor and/or coordinator.
- Responsible for training/orienting new Housekeeping Team Members.
- Starting wage is \$18.50/hour

- Keeps a clean, neat environment for Residents in their rooms, apartments, and public areas.
- Keeps restrooms, stairwells, elevators, storage rooms, etc. clean.
- Empty trash.
- Linen Exchanging.
- Vacuum furniture.
- Starting wage \$16.00/hr
